## Elementary School building



Arrival and dismissal times will be staggered to prevent large group gatherings. Dismissal will be outside.



Students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classrooms every day. Cleaning supplies will be provided so the desks/tables can be cleaned after breakfast, before and after lunch. Students will wash their hands before lunch.

## PLAYGROUND

Recess times will be scheduled to limit the amount of students on the playground at any one time. Students will wash/sanitize hands before and after using the playground. All playground equipment will be cleaned on a regular basis. When possible, each classroom will have their own non-stationary equipment (i.e. balls, jump-ropes, etc...)

### MUSIC/ART

The music and art teacher will come into the classrooms during their scheduled time.

### INTERVENTION

The learning specialists will come into the classrooms to work with small groups of students.

## Middle and High School building



School begins at regular scheduled times. Grades 6-12 will be on a block schedule M,T, Th, F. Wednesdays will be online learning days. Dismissal will be staggered.



Students will eat breakfast in their classrooms every day. Up to 50 students may eat lunch in the cafe each day. Other students will eat lunch in their classrooms. Cleaning supplies will be provided in the classrooms so the tables can be cleaned before and after lunch. Students will wash their hands before lunch.



All students will be asked not to congregate in the hallway. Dismissal from classrooms will be staggered as possible. All students will be asked to use two-way traffic in the hallways. All students will be reminded to follow all appropriate health guidelines, including wearing a mask all day.

**MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Facial coverings will be worn by all staff at school and on buses all day.  
 Facial coverings will be worn by students in grades 6-12 all day at school and on the bus.  
 Facial coverings will be worn by students in grades K-5 on the bus and in common areas at school.  
 Social distancing will be done at school in all shared spaces.  
 Students who cannot wear a facial covering due to health concerns will need to submit a doctor note.

**HYGIENE AND CLEANING**

Handwashing and sanitizing will done on a regular basis.  
 Frequently touched surfaces will be at least every four hours.  
 Hand sanitizer will be available in multiple locations in the building as well as in the classrooms.  
 HVAC units will have IWAVE-C air ionizers to eliminate airborne viruses.



**COVID PROTOCOL**

Students will be screened daily as they arrive at school.  
 Families will agree to monitor daily health of their children and send them to school symptom free.  
 Landmark Academy will cooperate with our local health department regarding protocols for screening staff and students and if a confirmed case is identified.

**FOOD SERVICE**

All areas used for eating will be cleaned before and after eating.  
 Handwashing/sanitizing will occur before eating.  
 Food items will be individually packaged.



**TRANSPORTATION**

Buses will be disinfected after each bus route/trip is completed.  
 Bus windows will be kept partially open as allowed based on weather conditions.  
 All students and staff on buses must wear masks.  
 Hand sanitizer will be provided and must be used upon entering the bus.

**VISITORS**

Visitors will NOT be allowed in the buildings.  
 Families will only be allowed access to the building in an emergency situation.  
 Families will have a designated area to drop off items for students.  
 Families will need to call BEFORE they pick up a student and sign out the student from outside.

**WATER**

Due to CDC guidelines all water fountains will be closed.  
 Water will be available for students through the water filling stations located at each building.  
 Students should bring their own water bottles that are labeled with their name.

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
