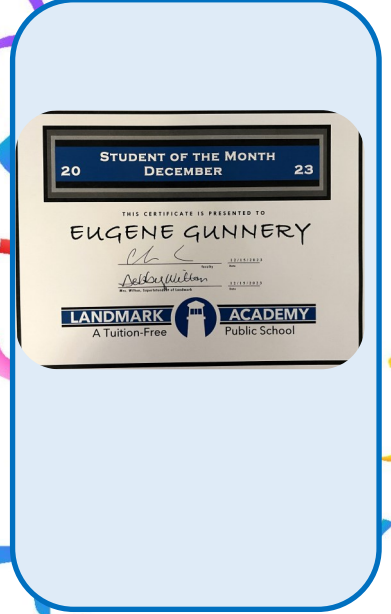

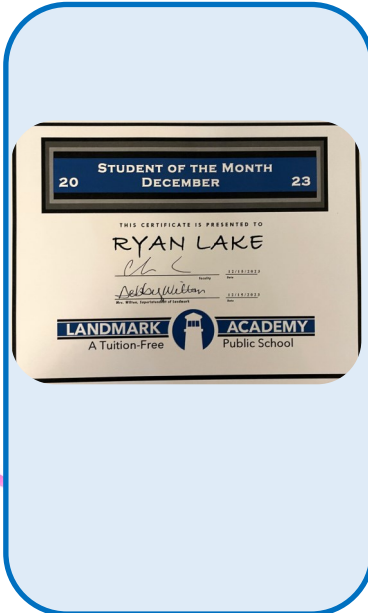

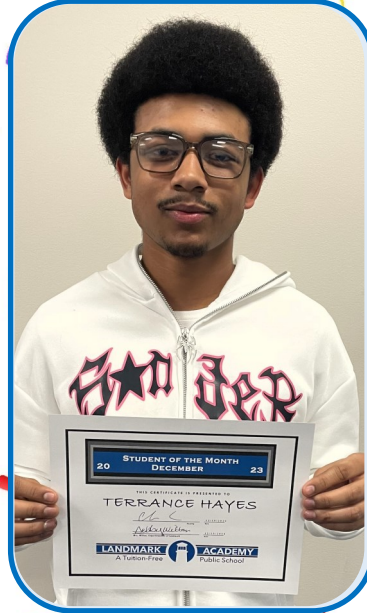

Season greetings to all! As we care for your child at school, it is very important that we know all important medical information. Please update the school with information such as:

- ◆ Medications your child takes at school
- ◆ Allergies - Please notify or confirm that the school is aware of severe allergies. If cafeteria needs to be alerted of less life threatening allergies, please make sure the school is aware of these.
- ◆ Please keep the school updated on any medical changes by notifying the school nurse. If you have already notified the school please confirm by checking Skyward which should have important medical information in the alert info box under emergency contacts.

Tip from the nurse: Hand washing!

- * Single most effective way to prevent sickness.
- * Have soap available at home in accessible place for family members to wash hands when arriving home.
- * Wash hands before eating any food
- * Hand sanitizer should not replace hand washing, as it does not do as good a job

Best way to know if your child should stay home if not feeling well is to keep your child home if they:

- Display a low grade fever 99.5 and greater
- Persistent cough
- Diarrhea
- Runny nose
- Vomiting

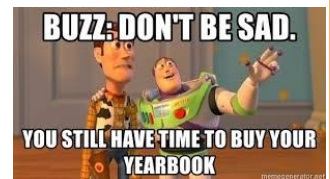

Family Access is a secure web application that provides you with direct access to your child's information via the Internet and allows you to view your child's attendance, grades, schedule, progress, assignments and emergency information.

Download the app from the appropriate store onto your device. Chose Landmark Academy School District in Kimball, Michigan.

The Skyward Mobile Access app is available from the iTunes Store, the Google Play Store, and the Amazon App Store. This app will give parents the ability to see their child's grades, and attendance on their mobile phone or other mobile device.
