Any Landmark Academy student who intends to pursue dual enrollment must complete, sign, and return this contract to the Landmark Academy Counseling Office by **May 30th** to participate in Fall (1st semester) dual enrollment and by **November 20th** to participate in Winter (2nd semester) dual enrollment

		Landmark will pay \$750 towards the cost of each class but the student/family is responsible for paying any remaining balance + books and supplies.
		Students enrolled in one Dual Enrollment course will not be scheduled for an 8th hour class at Landmark Academy.
		Students enrolled in two Dual Enrollment courses will not have a 7th or 8th hour class at Landmark Academy.
		Students enrolled in three Dual Enrollment courses will not have a 6th, 7th, or 8th hour class at Landmark Academy.
		It is the students responsibility to ensure that Dual Enrollment courses do not conflict with their Landmark Academy schedule
		Each successfully completed Dual Enrollment course will earn the student 0.5 high school credit at Landmark Academy, which counts toward graduation requirements and may also be applied as college credit at SC4.
		If a student does not successfully complete their college course or chooses to withdraw after the official drop deadline, the cost of the course will become the responsibility of the student.
